Comments (+)

- “I think they’re a great idea. Help is just as good, and I find that I think much better when I’m not in the stress of physical office hours.”

- “. . . they’re great for shorter questions.”

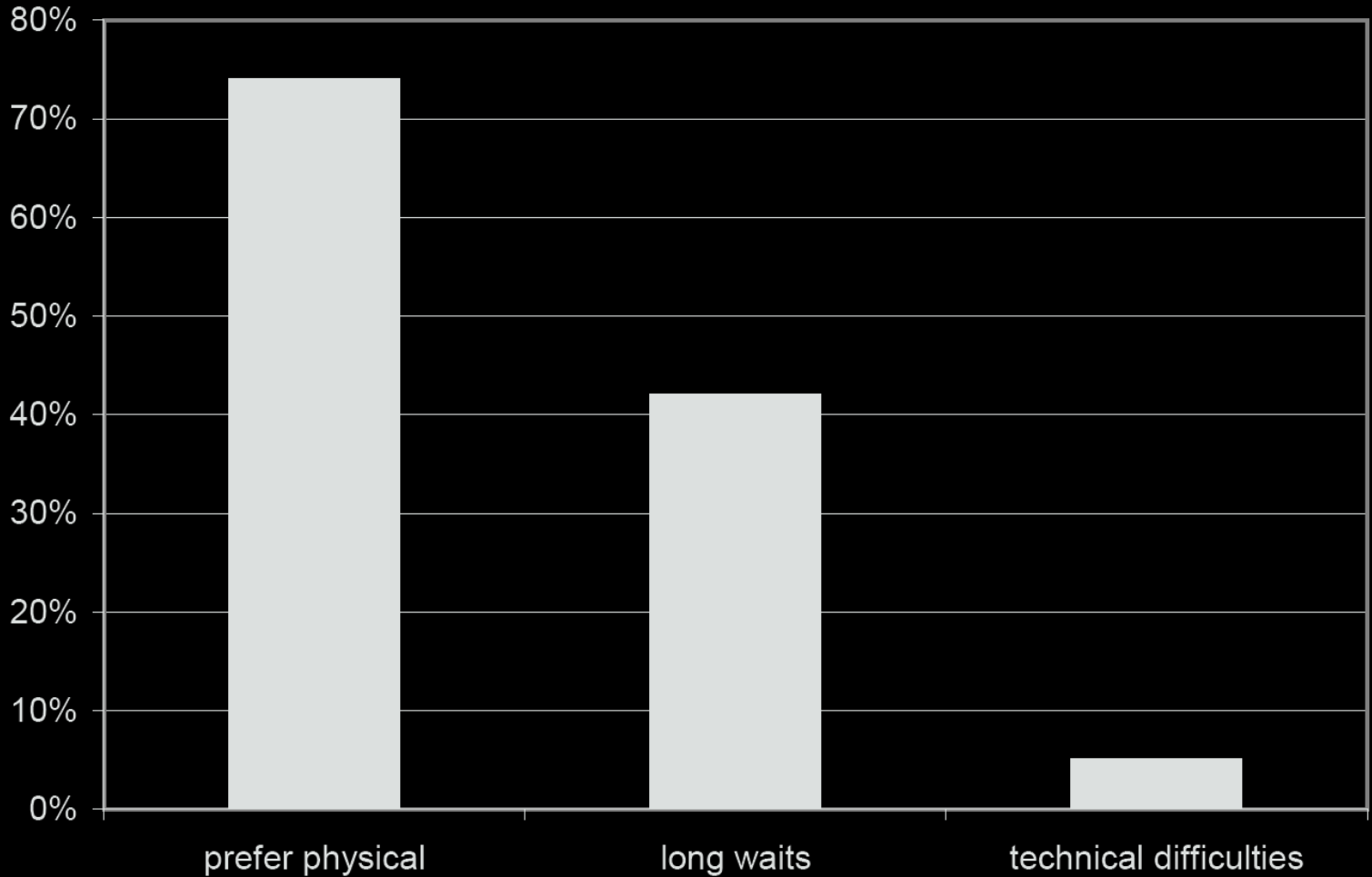
Theory != Reality

- “I think it’s a really cool idea, I just haven’t gotten around to trying it out.”
- “A neat idea. Haven’t used it though.”

Comments (-)

- “They are not as effective as the physical ones. The [TFs] can’t really give their full attention to the student.”
- “They are helpful for small questions, but not for understanding larger concepts.”
- “I really like the idea. I’m just more comfortable with someone physically there.”
- “. . . nothing beats physical office hours.”

Problems

- Latency
- Moderators can't be in multiple breakout rooms.
- “When a [TF] greets you, it's easy to miss.”

Conclusions
