City Sense ... Harvard, BBN Technologies, and the City of Cambridge have begun a four-year project to create the world's [first city-wide network](#) of wireless sensors.

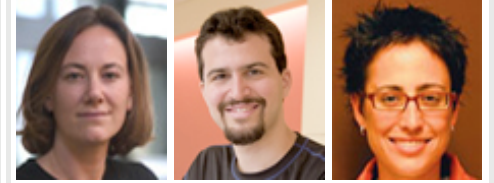
